


STUDENT-ATHLETE ENROLLMENTS

In 2023, we successfully assisted in enrolling 1,224 student-athletes in the US and Canada, representing a remarkable 20% increase from the previous year. The "enrollment cliff", linked to declining college-age demographics resulting from past economic challenges, has generated promising opportunities for international student admissions and scholarship prospects. Notably, the male student-athlete enrollment surpasses that of female student-athletes, primarily due to gender-specific sports participation.





The college sports system comprises various divisions, each distinguished by its approach tailored to the aspirations of student-athletes. The divisions vary, with some divisions bolstering high level of




sport performance alongside the studies, while others emphasize a more academically focused experience combined with college sports practice.

Across the different divisions, you'll also find varying scholarship amounts and the extent to which they cover the costs of attending college. For instance, for NCAA Division I women's soccer, our achievements have led to our average scholarship amount covering 89% of college expenses.




04. Numbers of Full Rides, compared to the previous year



03. Average scholarship in 2023


Full-ride scholarships are scholarships that cover all college costs, and some may go even beyond that. In 2023, 14% of our total scholarships were full rides, exceeding the typical 8-10% full ride range in education programs.




02. DIVISIONS OVERVIEW


COLLEGE SPORTS DIVISONS

In the US, sports are categorized into divisions with differing levels of sports practice and competition, tailored to suit student-athletes' various skills and aspirations. The major divisions in college sports include NCAA's Division I, Division II, and Division III, along with the NAIA and JUCO. These divisions govern intercollegiate sports. The U.S. educational system also offers younger students the opportunity to participate in interscholastic sports, referring to sports practice and competition on high school level.



NCAA Division I is the most popular for the student-athletes helped, particularly for students from Spain and the Nordics. While NCAA Division II schools enroll 32% of our student-athletes from DACH. The Nordic countries has the highest proportion of student-athletes enrolling at NCAA Division III schools. For the student-athletes from the UK, Junior College, commonly used as a great stepping stone, has been the most popular division to start their college sports career in.








Student-athletes' sport preferences align with the US college sports scenery. For instance, basketball and American football are deeply embedded in American culture and predominantly feature domestic talents.

International student-athletes instead gravitate toward sporting disciplines in demand in the US, illustrating the connection between sport choices and the American sports landscape.

In 2023, we had significant athlete placements in soccer, tennis, and track & field. Soccer has notably risen in popularity over the years in the US to become one of the top 5 college sports.

Among our student-athletes from Spain, 30% are placed in NCAA Division I, known for attracting students with academic aspirations as well as strong athletic skills and performance. NCAA Division II and NAIA predominantly enroll students from the DACH countries, offering exceptional opportunities to leverage their academic and athletic strengths.

ESPORTS SCHOLARSHIPS


